ANSI/ISEA Safety Vests

SECO's ANSI/ISEA Class Safety Vests

Many of SECO's safety vests meet the ANSI/ISEA 107-2010 standards for visibility. These help to ensure the safety of the wearer on highways and other jobsites on which it is crucial to be seen.

What does the ANSI Standard mean?

Complying with the ANSI/ISEA (American National Standards Institute) standard means that SECO's Class II and III vests meet color specifications, minimum levels of brightness, and the retroreflective tape has a minimum level of reflectivity. Class II vests are sleeveless, while Class III vests have 3/4 sleeves and possess the greatest areas of color and reflectivity.

Caring for a SECO ANSI/ISEA compliant vest:

Taking care of an ANSI vest means helping to make sure that it meets high-visibility standards for as long as possible. Refer to the vest's care label for washing and handling instructions.

The Vests:

Class II - 8063, 8068, 8069, 8260, 8265, 8290, and 8292

Class III - 8365, 8368, 8374, and 8390
